### **Dunton Recreation Ground**

The recreation Ground off Horseshoe Close was established over 45 years ago when the field was purchased by a group of village residents. A lot of work was needed to remove stones from the soil and establish a good grass surface suitable for a variety of sports.

The facilities were set up in trust with the Charity Commission and continue to be maintained by a small committee of elected trustees, assisted by a number of volunteers. Changing facilities, a small reception area and kitchen were built to accommodate Dunton Football Club, which in the 1980s had a successful team in the Bedfordshire Premier League, plus a reserve senior team and three youth teams.

The Pavilion has since been extended in stages over the years to provide the current facilities with kitchen and bar area plus a clubroom suitable for parties of up to 40 people, with full disabled and baby changing facilities. Currently these are used by the AFC Dunton Football Club who run a Saturday Team in the Bedford League, plus a Sunday team. AFC Biggleswade Youth Teams also use the pitch and changing area during the week for training. Improvements to the flood-lighting are planned to enable a larger part of the pitch to be used for evening training of football and other sports.

The clubroom is also used by a few village organisations for evening meetings and has a regular coffee meeting every Tuesday at 11-00 am to which all are welcome. The Clubroom is further available for hire for parties, meetings etc with special rates for Parish organisations, residents and families of only  $\pounds 6.00$  for the first hour, and  $\pounds 3.00$  per hour thereafter.

For the younger generation a play area was established on the north side of the ground which was considerably improved 10 years ago to provide a variety of equipment suitable for children of all ages.

More recently Central Bedfordshire Council laid hard core footpaths linking Fen Reach and Horseshoe Close with the Village Hall. To make the walk along these paths more pleasant a programme of planting of shrubs and flowers has been undertaken with the results hopefully providing good scenery for future years.

The committee wish all residents to make good use of and enjoy the facilities in the Recreation Ground but do request that they do not leave behind mementos of their visits. So all can enjoy themselves in safety we also request that the area not be used as a tip for domestic rubbish or as a canine toilet.



### Have you been inside Dunton Memorial Hall?

I imagine many of Dunton residents will have visited the hall at some time, either to access the Pre-school or to attend WI, an exercise class, Youth Club, a party or a village meeting. You may well have noticed that the date on the front of the building is 1925 and some of you may have attended our 90<sup>th</sup> birthday party last year. But how much do you know about its history?

An application was made to The Board of Charity Commissioners for England and Wales on 19<sup>th</sup> March 1945 and this was signed by Arthur Simeon Lee of Church Farm, Dunton, Farmer.

The aim of the charity was to be, `......the maintenance of a Village Hall for the purposes of physical and mental training and recreation and social, moral and intellectual development, through the medium of reading and recreation rooms, library, lectures, classes, recreations and entertainments or otherwise as may be found expedient, for the benefit of the inhabitants of the Parish of Dunton, without distinction of sex or of political or other opinions'.

The Memorial Hall is still run by a committee made up of interested villagers and representatives of the organisations that use the hall.

The original representatives were from:-

- The Parochial Church Council of Dunton
- The members of The Baptist Chapel at Dunton
- The committees, acting jointly, of the Dunton Cricket Club and Dunton Football Club
- The Dunton Branch of the British Legion
- The committee of the Dunton Nursing Association

# The Missing Steeple at St Mary Magdalene

Records show that Dunton Church

originally had a steeple. The tower and steeple must have fallen down during the mid17th century because a record states that in 1669 Nicholas Flott was presented "for Carrying the stones out of the Church yard, which stones belongeth to the Church steple." Three of the five bells were damaged by the fall of the tower. Only the arch at the west end of the nave remains from this original tower.

In 1710 the parish obtained a faculty "to sell the broken bells, to erect a new steeple and to mend the west end of the Church." This was completed in 1712 and as can be seen in the watercolour by Thomas Fisher painted around 1815 it was a very meagre affair. Archdeacon Bonney in his historical notices of Churches (c1820-1840) noted "The tower fell down before the memory of any person living at present and a bell hangs in a small wooden Cupola over the west end of the nave."

The present tower was completed when the Church was reordered during the 19<sup>th</sup> Century. *David Tant*

### Central Beds bus cuts voted through!

More than 1,500 people responded to cuts in the bus service consultation and only 1/3 were supportive of the proposals.

I attended the meeting where the decision was made and criticised the changes but watched the Executive Committee vote them through unanimously, resulting in £470,000 of cuts to bus services.

The cuts will reduce the amount of subsidies provided to ensure rural bus services operate and will axe funding to some community groups providing bus services to people across Central Beds who cannot access buses through reasons of age, disability or social exclusion. The impact of these cuts on route 188 which serves Dunton could be cuts up to 50%.

# Reporting potholes faulty streetlights, overgrown hedges and trees to Central Bedfordshire Council

The new reporting system launched in May 2016 by Central Bedfordshire Council in partnership with Ringway Jacobs can be found at <a href="https://www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/reportit">www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/reportit</a>. This provides you with information on potholes that have already been reported therefore you do not need to report the pothole again. You can also see the latest update on progress with that pothole.

You will receive a unique reference number for your report so that you can use the new 'Track It' tool to monitor progress.

Potholes are the obvious issue to most road users but the new system will allow you to report other issues such as faulty streetlights, overgrown hedges, trees plus much more.

Issues reported online are sent immediately to a Highway Engineer so the process of inspecting the problem and investigating it can start without delay.

### **Coconut Ice and Honeycomb for Christmas**

Most of us love the favourites at Christmas time, mince pies, fruit cake, sausage rolls, why not ring the changes and have a go at making some coconut ice and honeycomb.

#### Coconut ice

500g icing sugar 400g can condensed milk 400g desiccated coconut Pink food colouring

- 1) Line a 20cm square cake tin with cling film.
- Put icing sugar into a bowl, add condensed milk and incorporate with a wooden spoon, then get stuck in with your hands and knead the mixture.
- 3) Gradually add the coconut, kneading the mixture until all the coconut is mixed in.
- 4) Split the mixture in half. Press the first half into the tin, pressing it down with the heel of your hand. Colour the other half pink, make it as pink as you like.
- 5) Take small balls of the pink mix and place over the white mix, with your hands press the pink mixture evenly over the white mix to form an even layer.
- 6) Allow to set overnight in the fridge. Use a sharp knife to cut into squares.

### Honeycomb

100g caster sugar 4x15ml tablespoons golden syrup 1 1/2 teaspoons bicarbonate of soda

- 1) Put the sugar and syrup into a pan and stir together (pan must not be on the heat at this stage).
- 2) Place pan on the heat and let the mixture melt and then turn to a syrupy goo. Allow to bubble.... it should look like the colour of maple syrup... this should take about 3 minutes.
- 3) Take off the heat, whisk in the bicarbonate of soda and watch the syrup turn to a cloud of aerated pale gold. Turn it out immediately onto a piece of baking parchment, leave to set then bash it so it breaks into pieces. Karen Younger


