Volucella zonaria



Have you seen this Hover fly in Dunton? This is a hornet mimic and is one of the UK's largest and most spectacular hoverflies which can be recognised by its yellow and black banded abdomen. It seems to be found most frequently in urban areas and along the south coast from May to November. It was established in Britain in the 1940s and has very much a southerly distribution with most records coming from south of a line from the Severn Estuary to The Wash, however it seems to be expanding its range and appears to be in Dunton.

Planned Development East of Biggleswade

This summer a planning application described as a 'hybrid application' has been submitted to Central Bedfordshire Council, requesting full planning permission for 240 dwellings, with outline planning permission for subsequent approval for up to 1,260 dwellings, making a total of 1,500 houses. 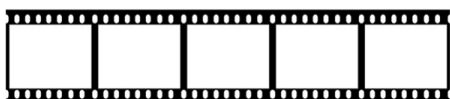

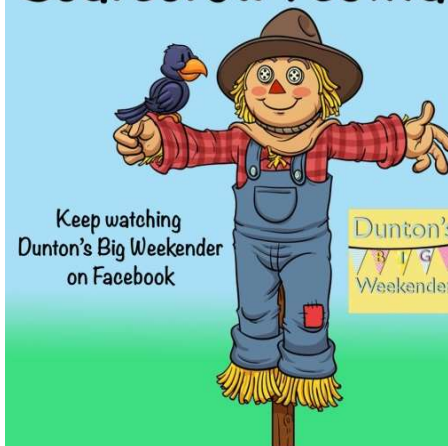
Dunton Oil Group is a village organisation to help those of us who use oil as our main heating source to buy it more cheaply than we could as individuals. There are 3 deliveries a year - in January, April and September. We order around 50,000 litres each time. This quantity gives us a price that is usually about 5 pence a litre cheaper than would otherwise be possible. 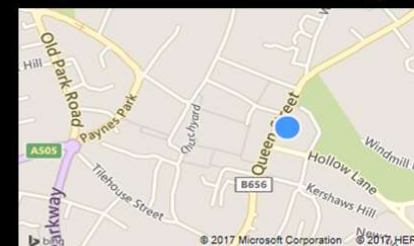
