Last February 30,000 quizzers in over 1,000 pubs raised more than £130,000 for over 600 charities. At the March Hare, on the 7.2.16, 11 teams participated with 56 players. £345.00 was raised, to be shared equally between Dunton Community Garden, Paediatric Intensive Care Unit at Addenbrookes Hospital and Guide Dogs For The Blind. This total includes the money raised by March Hare customers on New Year's Eve.
