

Congratulations to the Scott family for winning the most traditional scarecrow with Dilly Dally and the Dixon family for winning the most original with Ariel Just Chillin.





Dunton First Living Advent Calendar 2018

Join us in making Dunton a giant living advent calendar!

What is it?

From the 1st December 2018 residents, businesses and village groups in Dunton have been challenged to create seasonal scenes in their windows. Windows throughout the village will be decorated and the scenes will be lit consecutively each evening at 6.00 pm. Some residents are doing outside displays.

The windows will be prepared by the houses, businesses, and groups involved and a photograph of each new window will appear in Dunton's Big Weekender facebook page.

To start Dunton's Living Advent Calendar, lights will be turned on at 6.00 pm, where Biggleswade Road meets the High Street, also known as Vicarage Corner. Their lights are to raise money for Letchworth Garden House Hospice and St Mary Magdalene Church and so please be generous. The first window will be lit on the 2nd December 2018. By Christmas Eve there will be many different windows to see and enjoy as you walk through Dunton - a great way to get into the Christmas spirit. All windows once they have been unveiled will be lit until the 5th January 2019, culminating with Dunton Folk Wassail 2019 at Church Farm Dunton and at the March Hare, Dunton.

A trail map will be made available for residents to walk around the village to see the 'Living Advent Calendar' on Dunton's Big Weekender facebook page with hard copies at the March Hare.

Neighbourhood Plan for Dunton Parish

There are only four individuals that are prepared to work on Dunton' Neighbourhood Plan, including 2 Parish Councillors. Unfortunately for the village to develop a Neighbourhood Plan, more Dunton residents need to get involved. - ✓ Influence what new buildings should look like

However the policies in Central Bedfordshire's Local Plan will still apply to Dunton Parish, whether as a Parish we decide to prepare a Neighbourhood Plan or not.

The only way that Dunton's Neighbourhood Plan can be developed is by and with the Dunton community, which includes community organisations, landowners, local businesses and last but not least residents, with the support of the Parish Council.

Dunton Parish Neighbourhood Plan will require our community to reach a broad consensus on the key issues. Once adopted, policies from our Neighbourhood Plan will be taken into account when planning applications are determined.
